This research will develop and validate a Total Worker Health Climate Scale as a leading indicator of occupational safety, health and well-being outcomes

Potential Benefits to Participating Companies:

- 1) Identifying disconnects between company policies and actual operational practices
- 2) Improving employee participation across safety, health and well-being
- 3) Identifying safety program under-performance
- 4) Building a safer and healthier workplace
- 5) Higher job satisfaction
- 6) Lower turnover rate
- 7) Better engagement
- 8) Improving ROI

What companies qualify and what is required?

1. The company size is 500 or more employees from any industry, with priority given to the utility, manufacturing and transportation sectors
2. The company will provide a Letter of Intent to Participate to be included in the grant application (researchers will provide templates and guidance for convenience)
3. The company will allow all employees to complete a one-time, online 15-20 minute survey during working hours that can be completed on any computer, tablet or mobile device
