Travel and logistics guide for visiting residents

Stipend

Visiting residents will receive a \$3000 stipend for travel, housing, and meal expenses. The stipend will be dispersed by check on the first day of the rotation.

Flights

Portland International Airport (PDX) is about 15 miles from campus. Alaska, Delta, Southwest, and United all offer nonstop flights from many major cities.

We recommend arriving one day prior to the start of your rotation to settle in and familiarize yourself with the area and travel options to campus. Getting from the airport to your housing is easy by Lyft, Uber, or taxi; you can also ride the Max light rail (map your trip at <https://trimet.org/home>).

Housing

Visiting residents are responsible for identifying their own housing. Public transportation is available from all Portland neighborhoods, as well as neighboring cities like Beaverton and Milwaukie. OHSU's Marquam Hill campus (where Doernbecher Hospital is located) is in Southwest Portland.
