The Patient Centered Primary Care Medical Home (PCPCH) is a statewide program that recognizes high-functioning primary care practices and ranks them on a scale of 1-5 stars. PCPCH designation is awarded based on submitted data and interviews with all staff roles, and patients. Currently, OHSU Primary Care Clinics (IM, Family Med, Peds) do not have any 5-star clinics, until now! We are excited to announce that the Internal Medicine Primary Care Clinic has received a 5 star designation with less than 5% of clinics achieving this designation throughout the state. This designation is challenging to achieve and is a true testament to the care provided every single day to our patients.
